Hunger can't wait, SNAP can help!

Are you a college student who is struggling to afford food? SNAP is here to help. SNAP provides monthly benefits on a debit card that can be used for groceries.

Due to the pandemic, recent changes in SNAP policy have expanded SNAP eligibility to thousands of low-income CUNY students. **Many more students are now eligible!**

Do you meet the qualifications for SNAP?

Students who meet at least one of two can qualify:

1

The student is between the ages of 18 and 49 and is enrolled in an institution of higher education

- Must be enrolled full time or at least halftime (based on school qualifications)
- Attend a CUNY community, comprehensive or technical college

OR

Eligible to participate in work study or have an expected family contribution (EFC) of \$0.

- Note: students receiving the maximum Pell grant have an EFC of \$0.
- Must still meet state income guidelines based on household

- Apply for SNAP online at myBenefits.NY.gov
1. Submit your application through mybenefits.ny.gov.
 2. Schedule an interview
 3. Submit supporting documentation.
 4. Once approved, wait for your SNAP card in the mail!

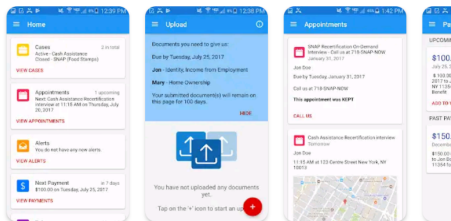
